 - Looking at the Christian icons and substituting simpsons characters for them
 - Make them look like a titian painting. As stylized as possible, without losing the characters
- Act 1:
 - Two line sets of trees fly in
 - Would like to confer with props about shrubbery
 - Designer and Director are interested in 3D trees and shrubbery
 - Director would like Gibson to enter upstage, so there needs to be a path for him to get between the trees and scrubs.
 - · Director would like Colleen to be obviously separated from the group

• Act 2:

- Car
 - Would be one unit that could be castor unit
 - Director would like the car unit to be weight bearing so actors can dance against it/on top of it.
 - Jadd is more interested in the car being able to be danced with/on than it being able to move.
 - Jadd is interested in creating a sense of scale in the warehouse.
 - "The more depth and distance as possible"

- Jadd doesn't want to see the outside, these people may have tucked themselves away within a city
- Director likes the idea of an asymmetrical set, an offset triangle.
- One of the entrances needs to be big enough to get the car in and out of.
- We might be able to repurpose the American Idiot windows

Box Office/FOH:

- Act 1
 - · Wants to incorporate making things with their hands, especially in Act 1
 - People developed practical skills in this world such as sewing, knitting, weaving, etc.
 - · Colleen has all of her stuff with her, separated from the group, covered in a lot of layers
 - Maria in some kind of cowl, maybe knitting doing some practical skill
 - Jenny more outgoing, open
 - Sam is the most comfortable in the woods
 - · Matt is very uncomfortable in the woods, dresses himself as what he thinks you should have in the woods
 - · Gibson runs the in between, crafty but not as at home as Sam, stolen stuff
 - Backpacks should be very character specific, and if a character is "related to it" in some way or should be costuming?????
- Act 2:
 - · Quincy's costume
 - There should be an effort towards being buttoned up and well dressed. She should be aiming for crisp well-dress, whatever that means in the world of the play.
 - Director picturing her as more of the show-girl types, a dancer.
 - All Simpsons costumes are nonprofessional but crafty
 - Pool noodle wig, used in simple ways, in Act 3 could be used much more impressively
 - The purpose of the ad medley is to inspire nostalgia
 - The show girl outfit should make us "feel a sense of time gone by but still accessible, similar to a Beyonce costume." It could be contemporary nostalgia.
 - Modesty isn't a thing anymore. It's not for sex, it's for fun.
 - · Gibson should be in his commercial costume at the top of Act 2
 - He can be in partial costume
 - His change into the FBI agent can be an onstage quick change. Director okay with pants staying the same
 - · Coleen is out of her shell, a little more comfortable, clothes are very distressed
 - Clothes are very distressed during Act 2
- · Will re-group with Director when casting is complete.
 - Once casted, Jadd will establish who each cast members will track through as and get that information to Alessia and Kyrstin asap.
- · Director imagines Gibson as gay
